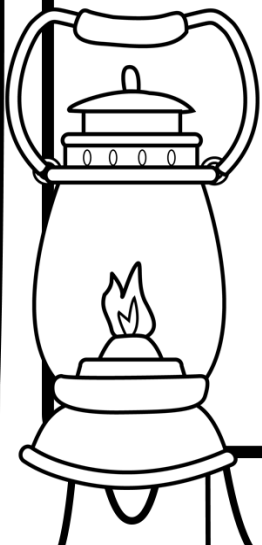

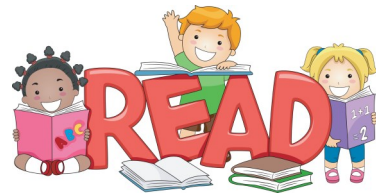
PTO MOVIE NIGHT
