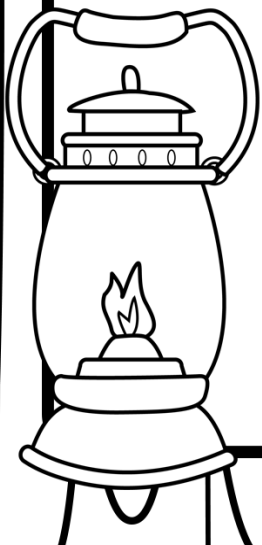

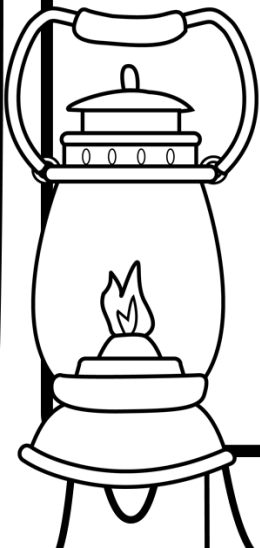
Required Reading
